The Government of Sindh (GoS) has received financing from World Bank towards the cost of the Human Capital Investment Project, Health Department Government of Sindh. The project intends to improve utilization and quality of the health sector particularly basic RMNCAH+N for and vulnerable population especially women and children, in targeted areas of Sindh. The Scheme envisages the "Detailed Design and Detailed Supervision (of work being carried out by already procured contractors and to be procured contractors) Civil works for Rehabilitation and Upgradation of 392 Government Dispensaries, 97 RHCs, 39 THQs Hospitals, 20 Public Health and CMW Schools, 04 RTIs and reconstruction of fully damaged 121 Basic Health Units damaged during flood. (by NCB method) including but not limited to vetting of Drawings, Design, Specifications, Bill of Quantities already available with client and their modifications / redesign if required.

The SIHPP requires the Services of an experienced Consulting Firm (The Consultants) for executing the project as The Engineer (according to FIDIC Rules) that has experience in Buildings Planning, Designing, Costing, Procurement, Project Management, Architecture, MEP, Construction Supervision, Construction Management, Quality Control/Assurance, Health Safety & Environmental Management.



No.	Criterion
1.	<b>Track Record:</b> Corporate Capacity (Core business, number of offices and years in same business, years in Rural sector). The minimum track record of the Firm is required (10) years.
2.	<b>General experience:</b> The firm must have at least ten (10) years of relevant experience in Engineering Consultancy and must describe its experience in Supervision and designing, and implementing similar nature projects (building works), for government and non-government agencies of comparable complexity / size, preferably in developing countries like in Pakistan.
3.	<b>Relevant experience:</b> The firm must have comparable experience in the required fields. Moreover, the firm must have experience of a similar nature completed projects, with a minimum Project cost of <b>PKR 5.0 billion</b> (Or equivalent amount) completed during last 10-years. Moreover, the firm must have experience of at least 02 similar nature projects successfully completed in the last 05 years as well as the firm(s) must have at least 01 similar nature project in hand of <b>PKR 1.0 billion</b> (Project Cost).
4.	<b>Overall managerial capacity</b> (Core managerial and technical staff) Experts with relevant experience of design and supervision of similar works across the globe and in the south east Asian region / Asian region the list of required staff is given in the ToRs (CVs will not be evaluated at this stage)

5. Interested firm must provide information indicating that they are qualified to perform the services (brochures, description of similar assignments, experience in similar conditions, availability of appropriate skills among staff, etc.). Consultants may associate with other firms to enhance their qualifications but should indicate clearly whether the association is in the form of a joint venture and/or a sub-consultancy. In the case of a joint venture, all the partners in the joint venture shall be jointly and severally liable for the entire contract, if selected. The firm will be selected in accordance with the Quality Cost-based Selection (QCBS) method set out in Bank's: Procurement Regulations for Borrowers Goods, Works, Non-Consulting and Consulting Services" (July 2016) revised November 2017, August 2018 & 2020 setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest.
