ORDER

NO.SO(PM-I)S-258/2016: With the approval of the Competent Authority **Ms. Seema Kanwal D/o Muhammad Haroon, Staff Nurse (BS-16) Sindh Government Hospital Liaquatabad, Hyderabad** is hereby allowed (02) years extension in deputation to work with **Ministry of Health, Kuwait** as per contract on the following terms and conditions:-

2. The period of deputation will be treated as Foreign Services and will commence from the date of relieving from the Provincial Department and will terminate on the date of resumption of duty under the Provincial Government.
3. During the period of Foreign Service, he will be entitled to pay, allowances and traveling facilities (including passage for herself and her family to the place of employment under the borrowing Government and back on termination of the contract) in accordance with the regulation of or the terms and conditions offered by the borrowing Government.
4. She shall, during the period of her foreign service, pay to the Government of Pakistan Mission in the borrowing country, in foreign currency in which his receive her salary from the foreign employer, pension contribution in accordance with the relevant rules and at the rates prescribed from time to time by Government of Pakistan on delayed payment of these contributions, interest shall be payable under SP-307. Till such time the rates of pension contribution are ascertained and intimated to the audit office, she shall provisionally pay pension contribution in foreign currency on the basis of the length of her services at the rates given in Appendix No. I-A to the F.R. SR Vol: II.
5. During the period of Foreign Service, he will continue to subscribe to the G.P Fund or any other Fund of the same nature of the provincial government according to the rules and other regulating subscription to the Fund. The amount subscription is payable in foreign other regulating subscription to the fund. The amount subscription is payable in foreign exchange every month to scheduled bank in Pakistan which shall pay to the Account officer the rupee equivalent thereof at the official rate exchange on the basis of her pay which would have been admissible to her in government service, but for her transfer to foreign service.
6. Her leave terms during the period of Foreign Service will be regulated according to the terms and conditions offered by the borrowing Government to her services, no part of the leave earned by her during the period of foreign service will be credited to her leave account with the Central / Provincial government who will not recover any leave salary contribution from the borrowing Government. He will also not be entitled to receive any leave salary from the Central / Provincial Government In respect of disability arising in and through service with the borrowing government.

7. During the period of Foreign Services, she will not be entitled to receive any leave salary from Central / Provincial Government in respect of disability leave on account of any disability arising in or through Foreign Service, even though their disability might manifest itself even after the termination of Foreign Service.
8. During the period of Foreign Service, she will not be entitled to any medical facility in respect of herself and family members at the expense of the Central / Provincial Government action.
9. She shall be on deputation with the borrowing government for the period original agreed upon, any extension beyond the original period of deputation shall not be made without the approval of the government of Pakistan, Sindh which will be treated as an irregularity on her part and may call for disciplinary.
10. Further, if she during the period of her deputation become entitled to any additional benefit or is appointment to any post involving alteration in her emoluments she will intimate particulars of such appointment to the Government of Pakistan / Sindh for information, any modification of the terms involving additional liabilities on the Government will require her prior approval.
11. She shall retain her lien, if he is holding permanent post, or if allowed by the Department as a Special case.
12. It is certified that a copy of other order together with a copy of the prescribed proforma duly filled in is being sent to the Finance Department, Government of Sindh and the Accountant General Sindh, Karachi / District Accounts Officer Concerned.


