**SUMMARY FOR CHIEF MINISTER SINDH**

**SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR ENHANCEMENT OF GRANT IN AID FOR SHAHDADPUR INSTITUTE OF MEDICAL SCIENCES (SIMS) DISTRICT SANGHAR, FROM UNREVISED RS. 300 MILLION TO RS.850 MILLION FOR FY 2022-23**

The Director Shahdadpur Institute of Medical Sciences (SIMS) District Sanghar has requested for enhancement of budget along with provision of budgetary allocation amounting to **Rs.850 Million** in favour of Shahdadpur Institute of Medical Sciences (SIMS), District Sanghar from FY 2022-23 and onwards (**Annexure-I**).

2. The Director, SIMS, has highlighted that the annual grant-in-aid of SIMS has been stagnant to **Rs.300 Million** from last five financial years and the impact of the insufficient budget could well be assessed by the fact that out of the allocated HR strength of **402**, more than **110 slots** are lying vacant due to non-availability of sufficient funds to pay additional salaries, which is ever-growing patient/doctor ratio and correspondingly diminishes the quality of health care delivery. He has submitted revised budget estimation for the year 2022- 23 along-with justification for up-gradation under mentioned heads (**Annexure-II**).

3. The Director, SIMS, Sanghar has further added that the institute is providing state of the art Dialysis services (second to SIUT alone), the institute provides, on average levels, the Health Care Services related to General Surgery, Gynecology, Coronary Care, Chest & Respiratory Care, Pediatrics, ENT, Physiotherapy, Ultrasound & Radiology, Laboratory tests, and Trauma Center along with the round-the-clock electricity provisions and covers population of 5 Talukas of the district Sanghar and hopes to cover further districts like Tando Allahyar, Matiari and Nawabshah in future after the enhancement of funds amounting to Rs.850 Million in the next FY 2022-23. The Board of Directors, SIMS District Sanghar has also endorsed the "Analysis & demand Proposal", submitted by the Director SIMS (**Annexure-III**).

4. It is pertinent to mention here that the funds amounting to Rs.300 Million has been kept under the head of account "SC21144(144)-Health Services-SN0095-Shahdadpur Institute of Medical Sciences (SIMS), during the CFY 2021-2022 (**Annexure-IV**).
